If you have answered 'yes' to any of the above, then this service can help you.

Centrecare Goldfields provides confidential counselling, support and educational programs for people experiencing financial difficulties. Services are available in Kalgoorlie, Coolgardie, Kambalda, Menzies, Leonora, Laverton and Norseman.

If you decide to make an appointment, you will speak with a qualified and experienced financial counsellor who will talk to you about your concerns and financial situation. Together you will discuss your options, identify goals and determine whether your counsellor will need to talk to another person on your behalf. For example, you may need assistance with talking to someone in a telephone company because you have not paid your phone bill and your service is about to be disconnected.

Centrecare's Client Liaison Officer will tell you what paperwork, such as bank statements, bills and pay slips, you will need to bring to your first appointment.

Counselling sessions last 50 minutes.

Counselling is not compulsory so you can choose to stop coming at any time.

Centrecare also provides financial management workshops for community groups and in schools.
