What is the Homelessness Accommodation Support Service?

Centrecare and Mission Australia work together supporting people who are homeless or at risk of homelessness and exiting crisis or short term accommodation to secure and maintain long term stable housing

Are you:

- currently residing in crisis or short term accommodation;
- meeting regularly with your accommodation provider and Support Worker;
- wanting to live in the South East Metropolitan area;
- looking at being housed with Housing Authority or in a private rental; and
- willing to work with a Housing Support Worker for ongoing support?

If you have answered YES to the above questions and would like to access the service then talk with your current case manager who can refer you.

How do we assist you?

A comprehensive assessment is completed with you to determine the most suitable housing pathway to help you achieve long term, secure, stable housing.

The service provides assistance:

- to secure suitable accommodation;
- to establish a home, including household items;
- with tenancy support to assist you in understanding your rights and responsibilities as a tenant;
- with financial matters; reconnecting with social and community networks;
- with referrals to Centrelink, employment, education and training options where possible;
- linking family members into local health and community services; and
- linking families into local schools and recreational activities.

Housing pathways can include private rentals, Community Housing and Housing Authority properties.
