





## Family Support Network

Family Support Networks (FSNs) are a partnership of local services working together to provide support to families and young people. FSNs provide a common entry point to many services in your area.

The Cannington-Armadale Family Support Network is led by Centrecare and Wungening. FSN's Assessment and Coordination service may be able to support you if you are:

- a family with dependent children;
- a young person aged up to 25 years;
- living in the Cannington or Armadale regions; and
- in need of support with meeting your family's goals.

## How do we assist you?

Once we receive a referral, we arrange a time to complete an assessment. We can support you in identifying your goals and accessing the right services that will assist you in meeting these goals. We then refer and coordinate to services or provide you with information.

## The service provides:

- Planning and goal setting;
- Advocacy and support in accessing services;
- Service coordination, not case management;
- Links to local schools, recreational activities and community support networks; and
- If you move out of the Cannington-Armadale area, you still may be able to be supported by another FSN.

Both Centrecare and Wungening agencies are committed to ensuring your information is protected and managed in accordance with the Privacy Act 1988.
