Family Support Networks (FSNs) are a partnership of local services working together to provide support to families and young people. FSNs provide a common entry point to many services in your area.

The Midland Perth Family Support Network is led by Centrecare and Wungening.

If you've worked with multiple agencies or services and need support, then the Family Support Network Assessment and Coordination service may be able to provide support.

- a family with dependent children;
- a young person aged up to 25 years;
- involved with multiple agencies or services;
- living in the Midland or Perth regions; and/or
- in need of support to help your family meet their goals?

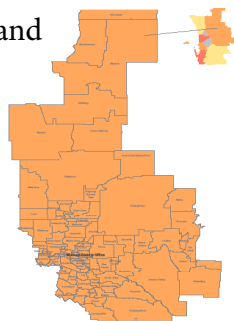

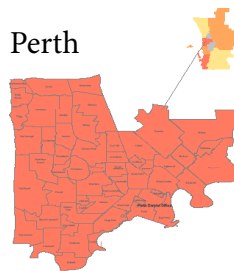
